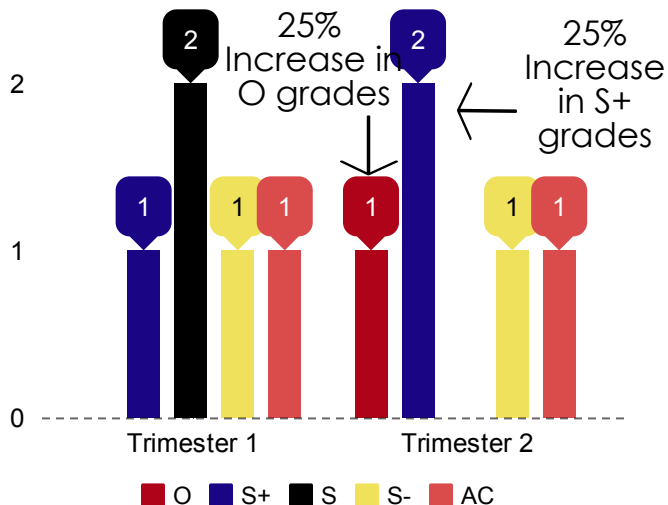

 Topics: Learning Styles, Goal Setting, Study Skills, and Time Management

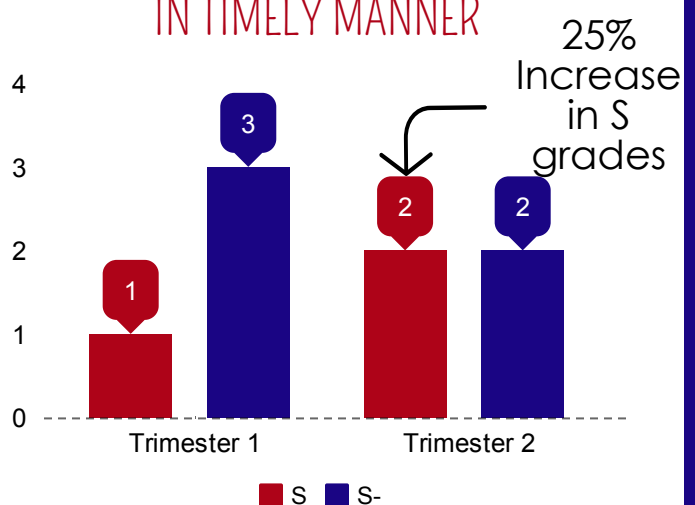
DATA COLLECTED:

0% >> 75% of students could identify the 3 learning styles

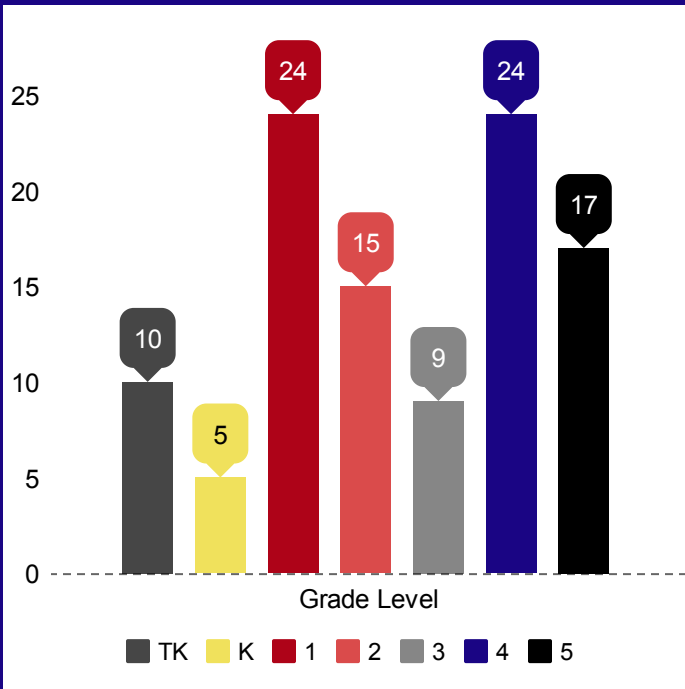
50% >> 100% of students reported they know ways to become more successful in school

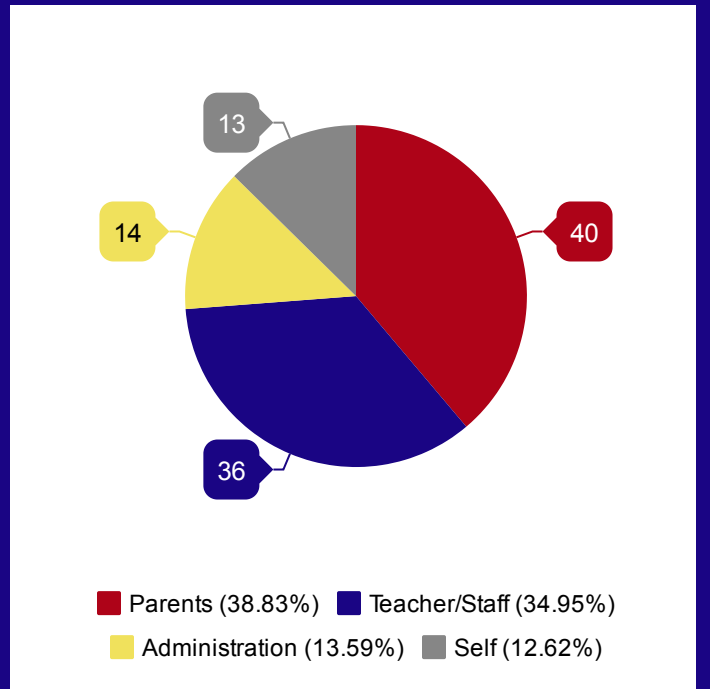

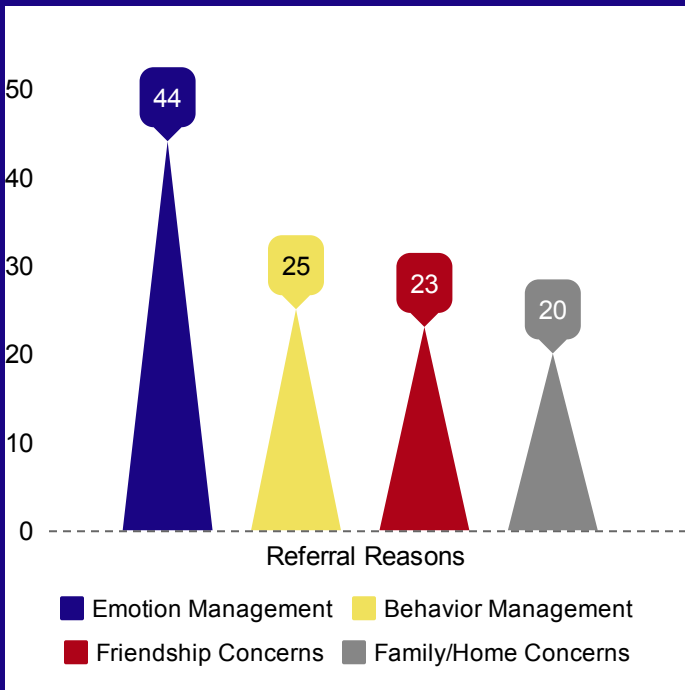
COUNSELING BY GRADE LEVEL
